In August, field crews will be conducting sanitary sewer smoke testing in selected areas of the District located within the North Sewer Service Area. Pushing non-toxic "smoke" into the sewer pipes is helpful in detecting connection points where outside surface water can enter into the sewer pipes. During

the testing, you may see this "smoke" coming from vent stacks on buildings or from holes in the ground. Don't be alarmed. 


