## Mitigated Determination of Non-Significance (MDNS) Conner – Jarvis Subdivision PSUB2014-00165

**Description of proposal:** The applicant proposes to subdivide approximately 45 acres (25 acres zoned Residential 4 units per acre, 20 acres zoned Residential 6 units per acre) including seven parcels into 115 single family residential lots. The site is located to the west of Issaquah Pine Lake Road SE and north of SE 42nd St and is constrained by a Category I bog wetland (Laughing Jacobs Lake) and a type F stream (Laughing Jacobs Creek). The proposed subdivision will be developed in three phases, two of the phases are located adjacent to Issaquah Pine Lake Road SE and one phase is located adjacent to the Kempton Downs neighborhood. The applicant is proposing frontage improvements to Issaquah Pine Lake Road SE and SE 42nd ST. The applicant has requested a variation to modify the street design for the internal subdivision streets. More than 45,000sq ft. of open space/recreational space will be created through the proposed development.

**Required Mitigation Items:** Probable significant traffic impacts were identified through the SEPA review process, which the applicant has proposed to mitigate pursuant to WAC 197-11-350. The applicant proposed mitigation on February 19, 2015 and March 12, 2015. The proposed mitigation is sufficient to address the probable significant traffic impacts, provided it is implemented prior to final plat. The following mitigation is required:

- 1. Conner-Jarvis, LLC will construct a temporary signal at the intersection of Issaquah Pine Lake Road and SE 42nd Street. Design of the temporary signal shall be subject to City review and approval prior to installation. Complete installation of the temporary signal shall occur prior to approval of the final plat of the Conner-Jarvis Subdivision.
- 2. Conner-Jarvis, LLC will pay Sammamish a proportionate share of the Jarvis impacts to the roundabout located at the intersection of Issaquah Pine Lake Road SE and SE 32<sup>nd</sup> Way in the amount of 2.5% of Sammamish's costs to construct the Roundabout, the total amount of Conner's payment not to exceed \$10,000. Final payment amount will be determined, and payment will be due prior to approval of the final plat of the Conner-Jarvis Subdivision.

**Location of proposal:** 4000 Block of Issaquah Pine Lake Road SE, Sammamish, WA. (Tax Parcels 1024069174, 1024069176, 1524069050, 1524069055, 3814500290, 1524069056, and 1524069080).

**Lead agency:** City of Sammamish, Department of Community Development

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that with mitigation, the proposal does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030 (2)(c). This decision was made after review of a completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the lead agency. This information is available to the public on request.

This MDNS is issued after using the optional MDNS process in WAC 197-11-355. There is no further comment period on the MDNS.
